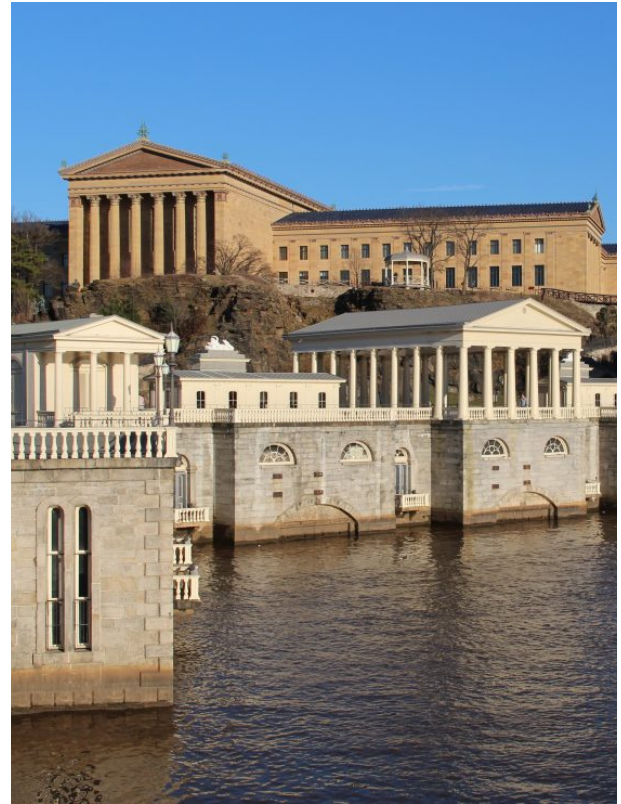
"Six weeks ago I began an internship at a consulting firm in the water sector. Although these six weeks have flown by, I quickly learned 3 major lessons. Let's break them down!

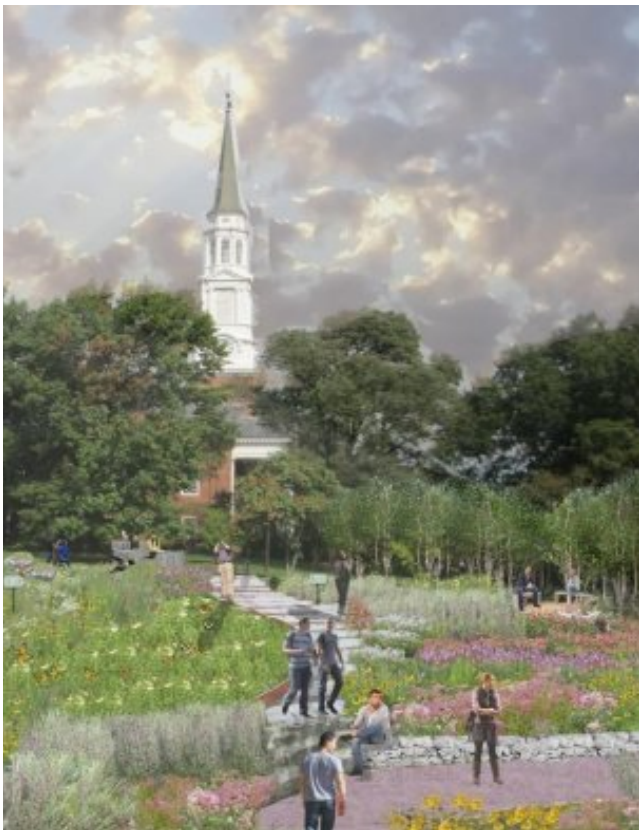
